ATHLETICS DAYS



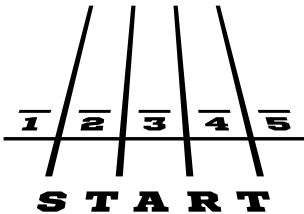
Year 0-2 Athletics

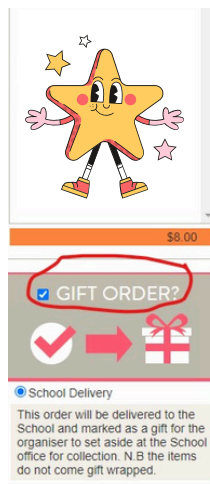

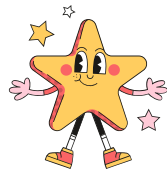

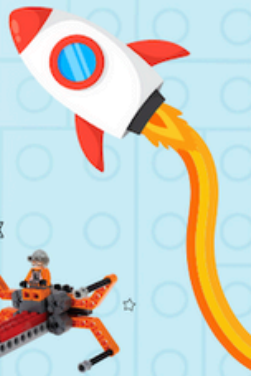
