Thank you for showing interest in the Philippines Missions trip scheduled for late November/early December 2024. We have been connecting with our Elim partners in the Philippines and an exciting opportunity is developing for our students. The trip will be led by Mr Charman and include Mrs Liu, as well as a local church staff member in the Philippines. This Missions trip is aimed to serve and support local Philippine communities, as well as transform the lives of our students by fostering a deeper sense of compassion, service, and faith. We want every student who joins this Missions trip to achieve the following:

- Reach, serve and influence to bring hope and encouragement Jer 29:11 that God has a hope and a future for every person.
- To grow Kingdom-minded disciples Matt 28:19 to experience God as bigger than just our local congregation, as we step into the call to go and make disciples in and of all nations.
- To develop maturity John 13:14 interdependence a heart to serve others, and a recognition that we reach the world for Christ in partnership together with others them and us.

This Missions Trip Team will spend time in two main locations:

- Quezon City, Manila
- The Island of Coron (a tropical island famous for scuba diving)

Costs

Please note these are estimates and guidelines. **Total cost: Approx. \$4000 (TBC)** Includes:

- \$3000 (approx.) for international flights, Travel insurance/person; Internal flight x 1; 1 Internal Ferry trip:
 - International Auckland-Manila-Auckland: \$2000 pp
 - Travel insurance: \$260 pp

- Internal flight and ferry (Manila-Coron-Manila): \$600
- 1 X night hotel accommodation near the airport
- \$1000 for all accommodation, food, tours, and any miscellaneous
- Additional personal spending money

Prices are subject to change and currency converter dependent.

Other important costs not included: Please ensure that you seek medical advice regarding travel vaccinations, ensuring your student is up to date with the recommended NZ Childhood Immunization schedule, which provides vaccination for Whooping Cough, Tetanus, Measles, Mumps, Rubella etc. A general physical and mental well-being checkup at least 3 months before travel is highly recommended.

With the costing's guideline and itinerary in draft form, we are keen to have confirmation of registration in joining this Missions trip. *Registration Form link and EOTC health form link*

Once final flight costs are confirmed, and we have final student registrations, we will then seek a non-refundable deposit* of \$500 towards the final cost, to secure your child's involvement in this trip. The trip costs will be added to your KAMAR parent portal.

The total cost is \$4000. The key payment dates are:

\$500 - Friday 26th July 2024. (Non - refundable deposit) \$2000 - Friday 25th August 2024 \$1500 - Friday 27th September 2024

*If your child decides not to go on the trip, we will refund the deposit only if another student has been pre-approved and can take their place. The final payment for the trip is due by 27th September 2024. If the trip is cancelled, the full payment will be refunded.
