Important Information:

- Students can either wear their Elim P.E Uniform, or dress in their Whānau colours.
- Students can choose to run in their sports shoes or barefoot.
- A warm jumper and rain jacket with them. All clothing must also be named.
- Students are to arrive at school wearing their cross country clothes for the day. Year 4 6 students need to bring their uniform to change into for the afternoon.
- If it is wet weather, all students are to bring their school uniform to get changed into for the afternoon.
- Please bring a water bottle
- Please bring a towel and plastic bag to store clothes and shoes in case of getting muddy.
